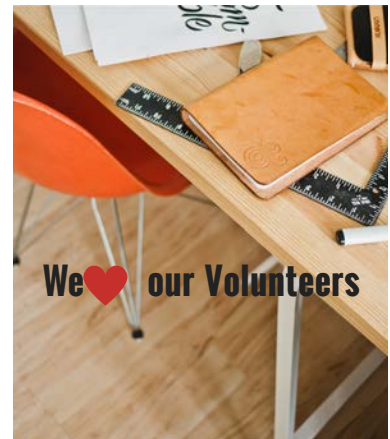
Toys for Tots
